RULES AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

“Corto e Fieno” (“Short and Hay”) first editions underlined the importance of cinematic representations of rural life in contemporary cinema. Considering the interest aroused by the sights and sounds of rural life, the fourth edition of the Festival intends to go on working on these subjects through films which deal with the relationship between man and land. The idea is to bring attention to the rural culture, both in our region and in other parts of the world, and to offer it as an example of an alternative way of life. The cinema permits creating opportunities to exchange knowledge with other communities which want to build a historical memory of their rural traditions through the use of interview, video and short film.

“Cinema acerbo” (“Unripe Cinema”) wants to enhance the creativity of film students who choose the rural world as the object of their audiovisual productions. The purpose of this section is to draw the attention of students, teachers and principals to the use of cinematic representation and to the importance of a reflection on the country and in particular on rural nature.

- 1- The competition is open to primary schools and high schools.
- 2- The Festival registration is free. All postal fees are charged to the participants.
- 3- The subject of the film must follow the general theme of the Festival regarding land’s life and work, and generally the relationship between Nature and Man. Different genres (documentary, fiction, video art, cartoon) are allowed.
- 4- The Festival will be held in Ameno, Miasino and Pettenasco in September 2013 and will be structured over several days of public events, according to a schedule that will be announced some weeks before the start of the event.
- 5- The duration of the short movie (titles including) cannot exceed 15 minutes. Videos both edited and unedited will be accepted.
- 6- All selected videos will be shown during the Festival’s days in the section “CINEMA ACERBO”. The Festival will get in touch with all directors and authors.
- 7- The jury will be composed of personalities from the cinema and cultural world. At the end of the Festival, the winning work will be announced. The opinion of the jury is not questionable.

8- All participants of the Festival “Corto e Fieno” can have agreements with guest accommodations in the area.

9- The received copies of the short films will become part of the Festival’s archive and will not be returned.

10- There will be a prize for the winner. The prize will be announced in due time on the website www.cortoeffieno.it (*Edition 2013 > Jury and prizes*).

11- The videos in DVD format must be received in duplicate by July 1st, 2013, together with the short films’ entry form completed in its entirety (the entry form is attached to this announcement).
